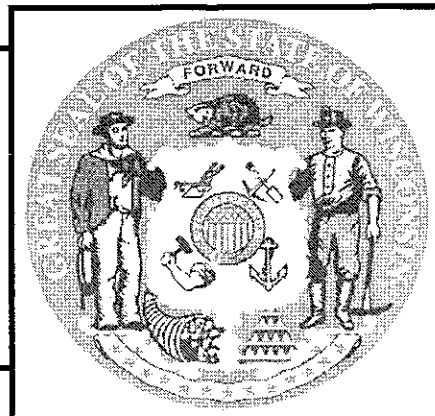

“Although I was unable to personally meet with those who stopped by my Kenosha office, I appreciate hearing from so many on the urgent need to create jobs in Southern Wisconsin and I agree that we must do more to get our economy growing again.
